Brother's Taekwondo Scholarship Agreement

1. Purpose of the Scholarship

This scholarship is designed to support our students' growth not only in Taekwondo but also in life skills. By emphasizing the tenets of Taekwondo – courtesy, integrity, perseverance, self-control, and indomitable spirit – we aim to develop well-rounded individuals who excel both inside and outside the dojo.

2. Overview of Scholarship

This agreement is between Brother's Taekwondo ("the Studio") and the scholarship recipient ("Recipient"). This scholarship covers martial arts class tuition and uniform at the Studio.

3. Who Can Apply

- Applicants must demonstrate financial need as per the Studio's guidelines.
- Applicants must be enrolled at the Studio.
- Applicants of any age or academic grade can apply.

4. School Grades

- Recipients must keep a "B" average or higher in school or show improvement towards a "B" average.
- Recipients must give the Studio their report cards at the end of each semester.

5. Class Attendance

- Recipients are required to attend and actively participate in at least **two classes each week**.
- If a recipient needs to miss a class due to illness or other significant reasons, they must notify the Studio ahead of time.
- Attending ten or more classes per month without being late will earn the recipient a \$10 monthly school gift card.

6. Length and Renewal of Scholarship

- The scholarship lasts for six months but can be renewed.
- To renew, Recipients need to keep meeting the scholarship requirements.

7. When the Scholarship Can Be Stopped

- The scholarship can be stopped if the Recipient does not attend enough classes, their grades drop, or they behave poorly.

8. Other Duties

- Recipient's should help at Studio events and promote the scholarship when asked.

9. What the Scholarship Covers

- The scholarship pays for all class tuition and the uniform.
- It does not cover testing fees or other costs.

10. How to Renew the Scholarship

- Recipients must show their report cards to the Studio within 14 days after their school's winter and summer breaks.
- The Studio will decide on renewal within 30 days after getting the report card.

11. Agreement to Terms

By signing this agreement, the Recipient and their parent or guardian (if needed) confirm that:

- They have read and understood this agreement.
- They agree to fulfill all the requirements stated.
- They understand that not meeting the requirements may lead to losing the scholarship.
- They accept that the Studio makes the final decision on continuing or stopping the scholarship.

To be eligible for the Brother's Taekwondo Scholarship, applicants must demonstrate financial need based on the following criteria:

Income Thresholds:

- Family of four: Maximum annual income of \$40,000.
- Adjust this threshold by \$10,000 for each additional or fewer family member.

Required Documentation:

- Verification of Income: Provide a pay stub or benefits statement.
- Additional Documents: Other forms of verification available upon request.

If your family has faced significant financial challenges such as high medical expenses, recent unemployment, or other unique financial burdens, please provide a detailed explanation. These circumstances will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Verification Process:

All financial information provided will be reviewed by a scholarship committee to ensure fairness and thorough evaluation.
